

Our Lady & St George's School Energy Saving Lighting Upgrade



Project Overview

Our Lady and St George's Catholic Primary School wanted to replace their costly and inefficient internal lights with more reliable, efficient LED lighting and install PIR controls. They also wanted to upgrade their floodlighting to LEDs.

Energy bills were running high and internal lights were being left on when they weren't needed. The lighting was also costing the school in maintenance to continually replace the bulbs. The new LED lighting and PIR controls will improve the lighting conditions, reduce consumption by 68% as well as cut the school's annual energy spend per pupil by £14.

This was a SALIX compliant scheme.

The school worked with the London Borough of Waltham Forest to develop the project and Salix Finance were able to offer the school finance to cover the costs of the project.

The additional benefits; Brighter lighting providing a more comfortable learning environment for pupils and staff. The school has a Silver ECO Schools award and the pupils are also engaged in a switching off lights campaign.
